### INTRODUCTION

This one-off event is being organised jointly by the Nuclear Institute (NI) and National Skills Academy Nuclear (NSAN) in association with Working Smart Limited – a global energy recruitment company which for 25 years has specialised in the oil and gas sector. The event has come about as an effort to help nuclear companies meet their immediate human resource challenges in adapting to a rapidly growing market for nuclear skills.

The event was envisaged mainly as a member benefit for companies which are members of the NI and/ or NSAN in order to help our members find the types of skills and professionalism that they need now, in addition to our key role of meeting the skills and professionalism needs of the future.

Due to the energy transition, the oil and gas sector has seen a large drop in staff and future vacancies in recent months and this is not likely to change much in the short term. After a survey of the skills needs of NI/NSAN members it seems that many of those skills are already present in ex-oil and gas sector workers and that crossover training into nuclear would boost the numbers available to existing vacancies in the nuclear sector.

## **HOW IT WILL WORK**

Working Smart hosts a large database of 60K+ candidates from 186 countries from all sectors of oil and gas, petrochemical and in recent years renewables. Many are senior level professionals, with a mix of mid-tier, junior and graduates – covering engineering, scientific, technical, operational, commercial and management expertise.

In advance of the event your jobs will be made available to all those on the Working Smart's database. Potential candidates will be headhunted and invited to apply. Working Smart Recruiters will screen and shortlist applicants and make available CVs for you to review and select for interview in person or virtually at the event. This service is FREE to all exhibitors, however, if you then chose to recruit one or more applicants you will pay a placement fee of 12% for technical roles and 15% for senior level management roles based on the job value. Details will be sent to all exhibitors who wish to make use of this service.

In addition, we expect that a range of other job seekers will be attracted to attend the recruitment fair which could include graduates and/or apprentices. All attendees will register in advance of attending.

We are not limiting the number of jobs that a company might wish to advertise in advance and there is no requirement to make use of this service, but the price for doing so is the same as having only a stand at the exhibition. We have 8 interview rooms above the Exhibition Hall, all named after well-known UK nuclear sites, and interview schedules will be made available to the candidates and exhibitors. Sponsorship of the interview rooms is available.

#### **CONFERENCE SESSION**

There will be a meeting session as part of the event which will run alongside the exhibition. This will run a programme of presentations on what the industry has to offer to new recruits and will feature presentations from NI, NSAN and the YGN about our work. Companies are also invited to present as one of the benefits of main conference sponsorship

#### CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

- 1 Only nuclear companies and nuclear supply chain companies who recruit staff directly to work in their organisations are eligible to take part. This event is not open to recruitment agencies.
- 2 Each recruiter is entitled to send four delegates as part of their stand support team. All delegates must pre-register.
- 3 Stand build must take place between 6.30pm and 10pm on Monday 11 July. Breakdown is from 7-8pm on Tuesday 12 July.
- 4 The price of your stand includes the following: access to a jobs board to pre-load your available jobs, a space for either a shell stand or your own freestanding exhibition stand, power supply, signage, inclusion in any publicity materials either before or during the event, spotlights, wi-fi, unlimited tea and coffee from a central location during the day.
