### **Terms and conditions**

#### 1. Eligibility

Any university or college offering nuclearrelated, STEM-related, or PhD-level courses is eligible to apply for Education Affiliate membership.

#### 2. Who can be registered

Departments may register the following individuals for free Affiliate membership: a. Undergraduate and postgraduate students, regardless of their degree discipline

b. Students enrolled in Levels 2–5 programmes that serve as a pathway to a career in nuclear

c. PhD and research students

#### 3. Membership Duration and Fees

Membership follows the calendar year and must be renewed annually, with payment due on 1 January each year. The Nuclear Institute reserves the right to adjust membership fees or benefits annually.

#### 4. Non-Payment

Failure to pay membership fees on time may result in the termination of membership and all related benefits.

#### 5. Course Endorsement

Education Affiliate membership does not constitute endorsement of any courses by the Nuclear Institute. Course endorsement is a separate, optional service that requires a formal application and supporting documentation. Additional details are available upon request.
